### 4. Field Trip Fees

Travel within district - no charge (curricular or extra-curricular)

Travel outside district - varies depending on distance travelled and mode of transportation. The school will work with the organizing group to keep travel costs as low as possible. Students are responsible for food, accommodation and activity expenses.

#### 5. Athletic Fees

\*Athletic Fees cover regular league expenses including referee, transportation, tournament and uniform costs. A uniform fee of \$30 and Athletic Banquet fee of \$25 will be charged for each student. If a student loses their uniform, a replacement cost will apply. Students are responsible for food, accommodation, and activity expenses for all tournaments. The school also supports each team by supplementing transportation costs, paying for accommodations and food for coaches and chaperones and paying for all TTOC costs.
